## THE NONPROFIT SECTOR ECONOMIC IMPACT REPORT

### NATIONAL DATA

Nonprofit organizations **EMPLOY** more than **10%** of the American workforce.

Nonprofits pay more than **\$634 BILLION** in **WAGES** each year.

Nonprofits contribute **2.1%** to the nation's GDP.



Americans **GAVE** more than **\$390 BILLION** to charities in 2016.

More than **72%** of all charitable giving comes from **INDIVIDUALS**.

In 2016, **63 MILLION** Americans contributed more than **8 BILLION HOURS** of volunteer service worth an estimated **\$193 BILLION**.

**POPULATION 3,930,864**

In 2017, there were **19,565 NONPROFITS** in the state.

In 2017, Oklahoma nonprofits contribute nearly **\$15.3 BILLION** in revenue and hold more than **\$48.8 BILLION** in assets.

Oklahomans **GAVE** more than **\$2.5 BILLION** to charities in 2017 totaling **4.46%** of income.

Oklahomans provide more than **94 MILLION HOURS** of volunteer service worth more than **\$2.6 BILLION**.
