NATIONAL DATA

Nonprofit organizations **EMPLOY** more than **10%** of the American workforce.

Nonprofits pay more than **\$670 BILLION** in **WAGES** each year.

Nonprofits contribute **5.4%** to the nation's GDP.



Americans **GAVE** more than **\$410 BILLION** to charities in 2017.

79% of all charitable giving comes from **INDIVIDUALS** and **BEQUESTS**.

In 2016, **64 MILLION** Americans contributed more than **8 BILLION HOURS** of volunteer service worth an estimated **\$195 BILLION**.
